Third – Governor Sam: Received early training at Ciaran Dunne's Wavertree Stables, who consigned him to the 2024 OBS Spring Sale where Bregman Family Racing and Ivan Cabrera purchased him for \$275,000.

\$2 MILLION BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE FILLIES

Winner – Immersive: Graduate of the early training program at Bridlewood Farm in Ocala, Fla.

\$1 MILLION BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE TURF

Second – Iron Man Cal: Graduate of Eddie Woods Stable
