A completed and signed official application form provided by the Florida Thoroughbred Breeders' and Owners' Association (FTBOA), accompanied by the appropriate registration fee, must be received by the FTBOA annually for each stallion to be registered and eligible to receive Stallion Awards.

Registrations for 2026 received on or before February 15, 2026 require a fee of \$2,000. Registrations received from February 16 through August 1, 2026 require a fee of \$3,000. Registrations received from August 2, 2026 through November 15, 2026 require a fee of \$10,000. Registrations and/or fees submitted by mail will be considered received by the FTBOA on the date of mailing if postmarked no later than the applicable deadline.

Registration also makes the stallion's Florida-bred foals born in 2027 eligible for the Florida Sire Stakes (FSS) and other FTBOA racing incentives if the foal is appropriately registered as a Florida-bred with the FTBOA and all additional FSS eligibility payments for the foal are timely submitted.

2025 OFFICIAL APPLICATION - ANNUAL REGISTRATION OF FLORIDA THOROUGHBRED STALLIONS

AWARDS/ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Foals born in 2027 by Florida Stallions registered with the FTBOA in 2026 will be eligible for the Florida Sire Stakes (FSS) if the foal is appropriately registered with both the FTBOA and The Jockey Club. Additional FSS eligibility payments for each foal are required.
- 2. This application, accompanied by the appropriate registration fee, must be received by the FTBOA in order for:
 - The Stallion Owner to be eligible for Stallion Awards. Note that the payment of Stallion Awards is conditioned upon the terms of the FTBOA's Annual Awards Plan, which must be submitted to and approved by the Florida Gaming Control Commission each calendar year.
 - The Breeder of a Florida-bred foal registered with the FTBOA to be eligible for Breeder Awards on purse supplements from certain Florida stakes funds reserved for Florida-breds sired by Florida stallions registered with the FTBOA.
 - The Owner of a Florida-bred foal registered with the FTBOA and sired by a Florida stallion to be eligible for those FTBOA racing incentives reserved for Florida-bred foals sired by Florida stallions registered with the FTBOA, including the Florida Sire Stakes. Note that such eligibility is conditioned upon the timely receipt of all necessary eligibility payments for the foal.

STALLION STATUS CHANGE

If a stallion continues to stand in Florida throughout each breeding season (February 1 – June 15) and to be registered annually with the FTBOA – both in the year of breeding and in each subsequent year up through the year its offspring wins a qualifying race – then the stallion owner is entitled to receive the resulting stallion award. If a stallion is moved from the state after June 15, the stallion will remain eligible for stallion awards until February 1 of the following year. With respect to stallion award eligibility for a stallion that is removed from Florida at any point during a breeding season or for a stallion that is deceased, please see Fla. Stat. §550.2625(3)(e).

It is the responsibility of the stallion owner or syndicate manager to immediately notify the FTBOA in writing if a stallion is relocated, dies, is no longer standing in this state, or is moved beyond the boundaries of Florida at any point during the breeding season (February 1 – June 15).

NOTE

The FTBOA makes every effort to encourage stallion owners to register their stallions. Registration, however, is not mandatory. The FTBOA accepts no responsibility to shareholders in syndicated stallions in the event a syndicate manager does not register a stallion for participation in the program.
